Summary of Weekly Themes: Around the World

This summer we will be learning about how we live and enjoy life in all areas around the world. We will look at how we are all the same and how we are unique and different. Maria Montessori's vision was to educate children to be compassionate, joyful, and thankful. We will also have a corresponding virtue that we will be discussing and practicing. This learning atmosphere will create harmony and peace.

Week 1: July 1-5- CLOSED

Week 2: July 8-12- Beautiful Places/Thankfulness

We will be looking at some natural and manmade wonders: The majestic Taj Mahal, the sweeping Sahara Desert, the exciting Amazon River, mysterious Pacific Northwest Rainforest and the incredible Swiss Alps. We will practice being mindful and thankful as we take time to breathe and enjoy learning about these beautiful places of the world.

Week 3: July 15-19- Housing/ Cleanliness

We will be learning all about the climate and the many affects it has on how we build our unique and diverse homes. We will be constructing models, measuring and having a great time as we design our very own house plans. We will discuss the importance of different chores in our family homes, and we will learn and practice different ways of cleaning!

Week 4: July 22-26- Families/Gentleness

We will learn about a variety of different cultures and special family traditions. We will make our own family trees and learn about how some members of our family may have lived in other countries around the world. Gentleness will be a focus as we talk about how and why we show our love for one another. We will come up with some new ways to share love and kindness with our families and friends.

Week 5: July 29-August 2- Music/Enthusiasm

We will be learning all about the importance of music and dance around our world. We will find out about the didgeridoo, various drums, pan flutes and even the sitar! We will be dancing through the days as we also find out about some various composers. Enthusiasm and creativity will be rocking this week!

Week 6: August 6-9th (*4-day week) - Transportation/Trust

We will explore the many ways that people around the world transport themselves. Some examples will be camels, horses, donkeys, buses, trains and airplanes too of course. We will also discuss trust. Did you know that trust is actually very important for effective transportation and systems? This will be a great week of learning!

Week 7: August 12-16- Clothing/Unity

We will be discovering and colouring common patterns in various cultural dress; sewing doll's clothing; making necklaces, bracelets or earrings; exploring, discussing, matching various fabrics and so much more. We will even have a fashion show in the park! Come experience the excitement of diversity, learn about unity and gain some new hands on skills.

Week 8: August 19-23- Food/Self Control

We will be cooking up a storm! Corn, rice and bean dishes will be on the menu as these are staple foods for many people in the world. We will get to enjoy local fruits and veggies as well. Learning about the food bank and how important it is to those who are less fortunate will help us to better understand others. We will bake some healthy treats to taste this week. We will also make sure to be allergy sensitive.

Week 9: August 26 –29 (*4-day week) - School and Games/Respect

We will talk about the importance of why children go to school and do not go to work. We will learn about the different ways children travel to school and the many different kinds of schools. As every child has a right to education and must have time to play, we will learn many games from around the world. We will practice good sportsmanship while we play games.
